A Reiki share usually consists of several Reiki practitioners working on one individual at a time. The person receiving Reiki is fully clothed and lying on a massage table or sitting, the Reiki practitioners gather around the person and provide a Reiki treatment. These sessions are performed in silence, and only Reiki is practiced during a Reiki share. Group Reiki sessions are often stronger and can be deeper than individual sessions. It is a marvelous and often profound experience! (\$5 recommended donation)

Depending on the number of practitioners (4 or more) a treatment will be 10 to 20 minutes.
